#### 1. DRACAENA TRIFASCIATA - SNAKE PLANT

## 6. HAWORTHIA COOPERI - COOPER'S HAWORTHIA



#### 7. ECHEVERIA ELEGANS – MEXICAN SNOWBALL



## 12. AGAVE AMERICANA – CENTURY PLANT


