WHITE LEAD TREE – LEUCAENA LEUCOCEPHALA



A fast-growing, nitrogen-fixing tree widely used for fodder, green manure, and erosion control. It thrives in tropical and subtropical climates and is valued for its soil-improving ability and as a shade tree in agroforestry systems.



RED CALLIANDRA – CALLIANDRA CALOTHYRSUS



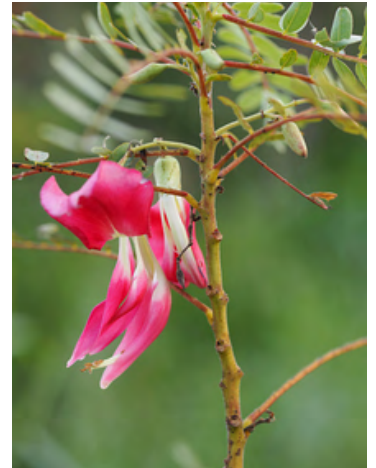
An ornamental and multipurpose legume tree with bright red pom-pom flowers. It improves soil fertility, serves as animal fodder, and attracts pollinators. Ideal for agroforestry, erosion control, and tropical landscaping.



SESBANIA GRANDIFLORA – CORKWOOD TREE



A fast-growing, nitrogen-fixing tree with soft wood and edible flowers. Commonly cultivated in tropical regions for food, fodder, and shade. It is well-suited for agroforestry and soil rehabilitation.



CASSIA SIAMEA – KASSOD TREE



A tropical evergreen tree known for its dense canopy and clusters of bright yellow flowers. Commonly used in avenue plantings, urban greening, and windbreaks. It is drought-tolerant and valued for its ornamental and medicinal properties.



AUSTRALIAN PINE – CASUARINA EQUISETIFOLIA



A tall, needle-like evergreen tree adapted to coastal environments. It tolerates wind, salt spray, and sandy soils, making it perfect for beach stabilization, windbreaks, and reforestation in degraded lands.



MESQUITE / ALGARROBO – PROSOPIS JULIFLORA



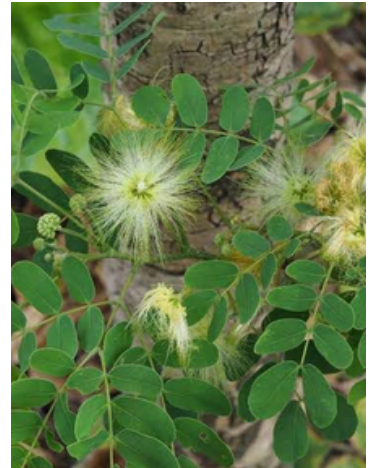
A hardy, deep-rooted tree highly tolerant to drought, salinity, and poor soils. Native to arid regions, it is used for fuelwood, fodder, erosion control, and desert greening. Its dense wood and thorny branches make it effective for fencing and windbreaks.



YELLOW RAIN TREE – ALBIZIA LEBBECK



A fast-growing deciduous tree with a wide canopy and bright yellow flowers. Known for its nitrogen-fixing abilities, this tree is ideal for providing shade and improving soil quality. Often used in urban landscaping and reforestation projects.



NEEM TREE – AZADIRACHTA INDICA



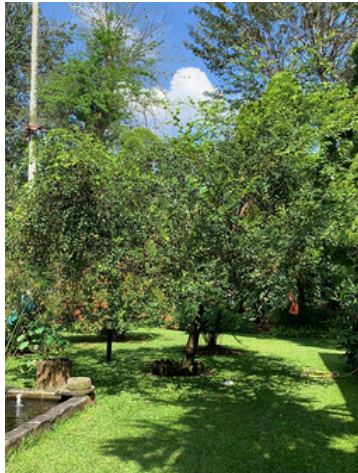
An evergreen tree native to the Indian subcontinent, prized for its medicinal and insecticidal properties. It tolerates arid climates and poor soils, making it ideal for reforestation and drought-prone areas. Widely used in traditional medicine and organic agriculture



INDIAN JUJUBE – ZIZIPHUS MAURITIANA



A hardy, fruit-bearing tree with spiny branches and glossy green leaves. The small fruits are rich in nutrients and widely consumed in arid regions. Drought-tolerant and well-suited for dryland farming and reforestation.



BOTTLEBRUSH TREE – CALLISTEMON LANCEOLATUS



A striking ornamental tree recognized for its vibrant red, brush-like flowers that attract bees and birds. Native to Australia, it is drought-tolerant and commonly used in gardens, streetscapes, and pollinator-friendly landscapes.



TAMARIND TREE – TAMARINDUS INDICA



A long-lived, drought-tolerant tree producing tangy edible pods used in culinary and medicinal applications. Also valued for its dense canopy, erosion control, and use as a shade tree in dry tropical regions.



SILK FLOSS TREE – CHORISIA SPECIOSA



A spectacular tree with a thick, spiny trunk and showy pink or purple flowers. Deciduous in dry seasons, it is drought-tolerant and suitable for arid landscapes. Known for its striking appearance and ecological resilience.



SIMPLELEAF CHASTETREE – VITEX TRIFOLIA



A fast-growing coastal shrub or small tree with aromatic, three-lobed leaves and purple flowers. Salt- and drought-tolerant, it's ideal for coastal landscaping, erosion control, and often used in traditional medicine.



BIRD LIME TREE / LASURA – CORDIA MYXA



A medium-sized deciduous tree bearing edible fruits and broad leaves. Valued for its fruit, shade, and traditional medicinal uses. Thrives in tropical and subtropical climates with moderate rainfall.



COUNCIL TREE / LOFTY FIG – *FICUS ALTISSIMA*



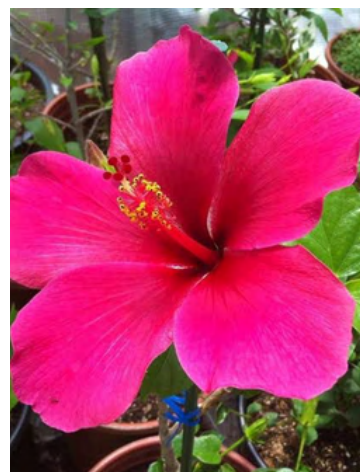
A large evergreen tree with dense foliage and smooth gray bark. Native to Southeast Asia, it is used in parks and avenue plantings. Known for its ability to grow in poor soil and improve air quality.



PINK VARIETY – *HIBISCUS ROSA-SINENSIS*



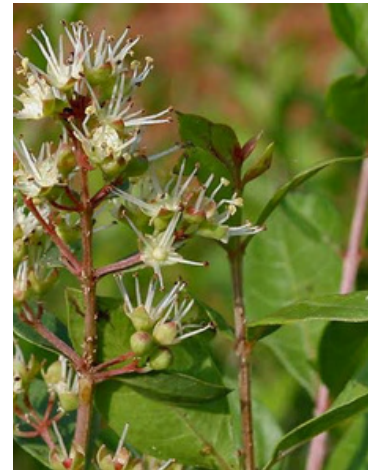
A tropical flowering shrub or small tree with glossy green leaves and large, showy pink blooms. It thrives in warm climates, blooms year-round, and is ideal for ornamental hedges, gardens, and tropical landscaping.



HENNA TREE – LAWSONIA INERMIS



A small flowering shrub or tree best known for its fragrant white flowers and leaves used to produce henna dye. It thrives in hot, arid regions and is suitable for ornamental or medicinal landscapes.



DESERT MIRACLE TREE – MORINGA PEREGRINA



A rare and drought-resistant tree native to the Middle East and North Africa. Known for its high-nutrient seeds and oil. Its deep roots and resilience make it ideal for desert greening and arid agroforestry.



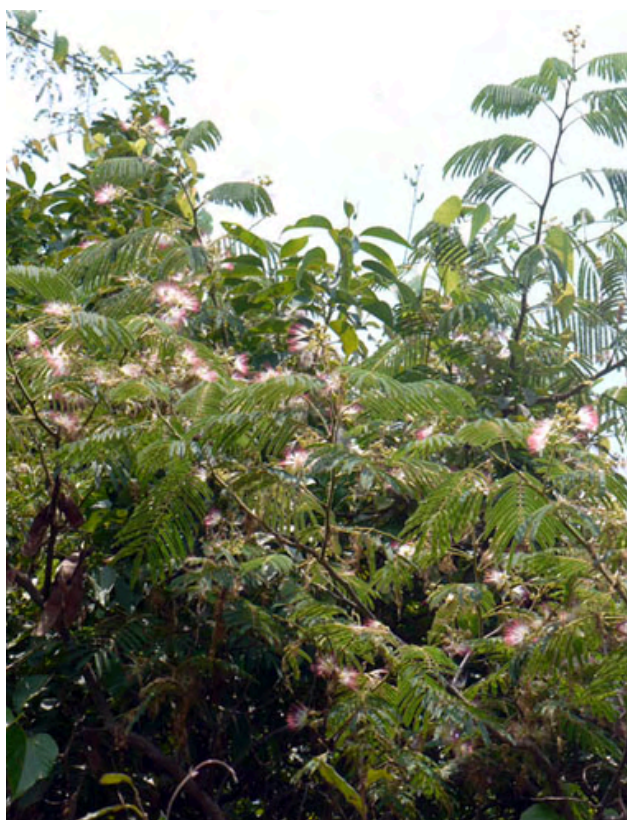
WHITE MULBERRY – MORUS ALBA



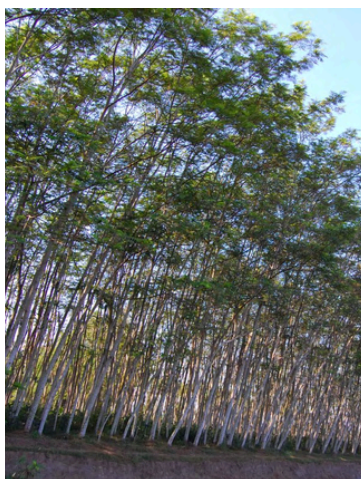

CHINESE ALBIZIA – ALBIZIA CHINENSIS



A fast-growing deciduous tree with a broad canopy and delicate, fern-like foliage. Known for its soil-enriching nitrogen-fixing ability, it provides excellent shade and is widely used in agroforestry and roadside planting.



SACRED BUDDHIST TREE – WRIGHTIA RELIGIOSA



A small, ornamental tree with drooping branches and fragrant white flowers. Popular for bonsai and temple gardens, it thrives in warm, humid climates and is ideal for decorative landscaping and spiritual spaces.



PERUVIAN PEPPER TREE – SCHINUS MOLLE



A graceful evergreen tree with feathery leaves and pink peppercorn-like berries. Highly drought-tolerant and decorative, it's used in xeriscaping, erosion control, and as a windbreak in dry climates.



ACICIA FORMIS – ACACIA AURICULIFORMIS



A hardy, thorny shrub or small tree with bright yellow, fragrant puffball flowers. Drought-tolerant and fast-growing, it is often used for hedging, erosion control, and perfume production due to its aromatic oils.



GLIRICIDIA / QUICKSTICK – GLIRICIDIA SEPIUM



A multipurpose leguminous tree with fast growth and high adaptability to poor soils. Used extensively as fodder, green manure, shade tree, and living fence. Drought-tolerant and ideal for agroforestry and reforestation in dry regions



YELLOW CASSIA – CASSIA GLAUCA



A small, flowering tree that produces golden-yellow blossoms in clusters. Hardy and low-maintenance, it is well-suited for dry, tropical climates. Often used for decorative planting and roadside greening.



INDIAN ALMOND TREE – TERMINALIA CATAPPA



A tropical, fast-growing shade tree with large, glossy leaves that turn bright red before falling. Produces edible fruits and has medicinal uses. Popular in coastal and urban landscaping for its salt tolerance and striking foliage.
